

This month, Governor Little signed House Bill 71 into law, banning gender affirming medical treatment to youth in Idaho. As mental health professionals, we uphold science, evidence based practice, professional ethics, and most importantly, human rights and autonomy. As an agency, we stand by statements made by the American Counseling Association and the National Association of Social Workers in opposition of banning gender affirming care to transgender youth.

We stand by our clients and community impacted by this new legislation and will continue to work to create an affirming space for our trans youth. You are not alone. Trans youth belong here, and we will not be silenced by this harmful and oppressive law.

Noble Intent will continue to provide gender affirming mental health care to our clients and seek ways to uplift trans youth and adult voices.
